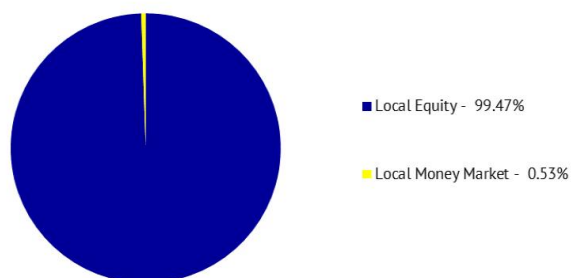

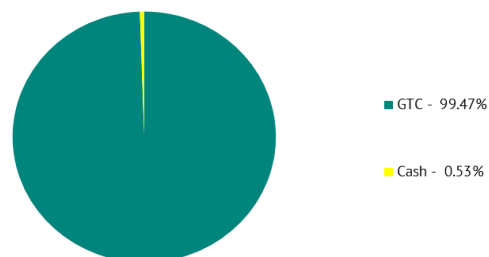
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Asset class exposure (%)

## Portfolio commentary: Quarter 1

The All Share Index was up 3.9% over the quarter with Resources (13.2%) and Financials (6.2%) leading the risk on charge while Industrials ended marginally down (-0.4%). Property returned 10.1% and cash 1.7%.
