#### Investment mandate and objective

The equity based portfolio incorporates value and core equity investment managers within a multi-manager solution that aims to outperform the FTSE/ISE Shareholders Weighted Index (SWIX) over a three year period. The value bias implies the use of qualitative and quantitative techniques to identify and invest into good quality companies trading at discounted prices. This combination of investment managers integrates risk management strategies to provide consistent returns with reduced volatility.


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


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#### Asset class exposure




#### Investment manager weighting
